Branson Airport unveils new nonstop service

Branson Airport (BKG), the first privately developed and operated commercial service in the United States, today announced new nonstop service between Branson and Austin, TX; Des Moines, IA; Houston, TX; Shreveport, LA and Terre Haute, IN. This new service expands the flexibility and convenience of getting to Branson, one of the most popular vacation destinations in the country.

The new service, to be marketed as public charter flights under the name Branson AirExpress, will be operated by ExpressJet Airline. These flights will begin May 17, 2010.

ExpressJet features a fleet of fuel-efficient aircraft with cushioned leather seating and no middle seats.

To inaugurate this new service, Branson AirExpress is offering low introductory fares for nonstop service to and from Branson.
