This year there are four great options for reducing or recycling your phone directories in 2010:

- **Quantities of 50 or more**
 - Directories will be picked up & recycled by calling the Girl Scouts at 417-527-5724; local troops receive \$\$ for the phone books they recycle.
- **Opt Out**
 - Eliminate multiple directories. www.yellowpagesoptout.com or phone numbers for opt out below and at www.bransonmo.gov
- **Recycle at the Branson Recycle Center**
 - Located at 606 Compton Drive, just east of the 65/248 interchange.
 - Tuesday-Saturday 8 to noon, plus Thursday 4-6 p.m.
- **Recycle at the large green bins placed at local businesses**
 - Wal-Mart on Hwy 76 (June and July)
 - Country Mart-Cedar Ridge (June)
 - Kmart (July)
 - Country Mart-Hollister (June and July).

A total of 31 tons, enough to fill 1 ½ semi trucks full of phone books, were recycled in the Branson area in 2009.
