Latex paint should be dried completely til hardened in can then disposed of in trash. Cat litter may be used to harden large amounts of paint quickly.**

<b><u>CARDBOARD</u></b>	Food boxes, boxes, beer, & soda flats, brown paper bags	No wax or plastic covered cardboard, No pizza boxes, No liquid cardboard containers	Clean, Dry, Separate from other papers
<b><u>NEWSPAPERS &amp; MAGAZINES</u></b>	Newsprint and inserts	Absolutely no food contamination,	Dry, bagged or bundled together.
<b><u>MIXED PAPER</u></b>	Hard back books, Phone books, Junk mail, cards	No food contamination, plastic packaging, No cardboard food boxes.	Dry in bags or containers.
<b><u>OFFICE PAPER</u></b>	All white office paper. Any papers you find on a desk	No small pieces of cardboard, No magazines mixed in, Just white paper only	Dry in bags or containers
<b><u>SHREDDED PAPER</u></b>	All shredded paper	No shredded newspaper	Tied plastic bag or box.
<b><u>TIN CANS</u></b>	All tin food cans Labels OK	No food residue, No paint cans, No aerosol cans	Labels OK. Remove food, liquids and rinse thoroughly
<b><u>ALUMINUM CANS</u></b>	Beer & Soda cans	No foil containers or aluminum foil.	Rinse thoroughly
<b><u>PLASTIC BOTTLES # 1 &amp; 2 Only</u></b>  NO LIDS, ALL LIDS DISCARDED	Soda, water, milk, juice, bleach, laundry <b>THREADED BOTTLES ONLY</b>	No plastic flower pots, oil, solvent, paint, or pesticide containers.  No # 3-7	Rinse thoroughly, they must be clean.  Must Have #1 or #2 stamped in a triangle on bottom of bottle.
<b><u>BATTERIES</u></b>	Cell Phone, flashlight, Car, boat, smoke detector		No prep needed
<b><u>SOFT PLASTIC</u></b>	Return plastic bags to your grocer or WalMart. Consider re-useable bags	Bubble wrap, shrink wrap, garbage bags, plastic grocery bags	Plastic bags not accepted after September 1 2011
