What is Operation Identification?

Operation Identification (ID) is a citizens' crime program to help safeguard property. The program involves marking property with an identifying number as a way to discourage burglary and theft.

How do I participate?

It's easy! Just follow these three easy steps:

1. **LABEL YOUR PROPERTY**

Engrave/mark your driver's license # on your property to help uniquely identify it. DO NOT use your social security number, name or DOB to help avoid identity theft.

2. **INVENTORY YOUR ITEMS REGULARLY WITH THE MAKE/MODEL/SERIAL #**

3. **PRINT YOUR INVENTORY LIST & KEEP IT IN A SAFE/SECURE LOCATION OR STORE IN CLOUD STORAGE SO YOU CAN ACCESS ANYTIME**

If any of your items go missing, you'll have a detailed list with everything we will need to help find your items and get them back to you!

Bonus Tip! Cut out the Operation I.D. logo and display it in a visible place. The logo warns potential thieves that the property is marked. This makes it more difficult for the thief to sell the property. If the property is found in their possession, it is evidence of their crime. As a result, this acts as a deterrent.
