



Memorial Tree Program

The City of Branson Tree Board is the proud sponsor of the Memorial Tree Program. This program allows groups and individuals to donate trees to memorialize or celebrate a friend, family member or co-worker. Trees purchased through the program will be planted and placed in city parks, playgrounds, or along city trails and road right-of-ways. Memorial Trees will be planted in the Spring or the Fall each year. Once the tree is planted, the contact person will receive a certificate and map showing the location of their tree and the recipients name will be added to a commemorative plaque at City Hall.

Your donation provides for the purchase, transportation, planting and continued care of a tree. Please choose one of the four donation levels shown below. If you choose a Pine or Maple level, you may select the species of tree and the location in either a park or non-park setting. If you choose the Oak or Hickory level, you will be eligible for a tree planting in the downtown location. Please note, the Tree Board and staff will determine the species and location of all trees to be planted downtown. Exact placement will be at the discretion of the Tree Board and staff.
